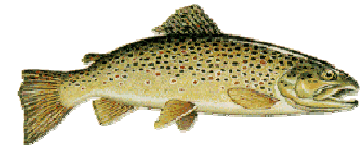
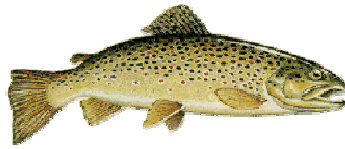
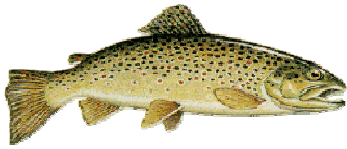

## What does Gold Country Fly Fishers do?

### Monthly Fishouts:

These outings give members a chance to fish new places with experienced fishers to promote learning and camaraderie. We also host a couple member BBQs annually.

### Information Sharing:

GCFF has a monthly newsletter and website with information on local fishing conditions, fly patterns and club information for ongoing and future activities. We have monthly meetings with informative speakers and program presentations.

### Instruction:

GCFF has regular instruction in fly casting, fly tying, entomology, rod building, and stream clinics. We have a gear loan program if you need a rod and reel to get started. We also have a full fly fishers library available.

### Conservation:

GCFF participates with local organizations like Friends of Deer Creek in ongoing local restoration and stream monitoring projects, a Trout In The Classroom program with the Grass Valley Charter School, the Boy Scout fly-fishing merit badge program, sign posting with California DFG, just to name a few. We also participate with SYRCL and their Annual River cleanup.
